The toys and equipment in the pre-school provide opportunities for children, with adult help, to develop new skills and concepts in the course of their play and exploration. The equipment we provide:

- Is appropriate for the ages and developmental stages of the children.
- Offers challenges to developing physical, social, personal and communication skills.
- Features positive images of people, both genders, from a range of ethnic and cultural groups, with or without disabilities.
- Includes a range of raw materials which can be used in a variety of ways and encourages an open-ended approach to creativity and problem solving.
- Will enable children, with adult support, to develop individual potential and move towards achieving the required early learning goals.
- Conforms to all relevant safety regulations and is sound and well made (should show the safety kite mark on the packaging).
